HISTORY

WestPac was founded in 1967 to promote the exchange of information and ideas among law libraries and individuals engaged in law library work. Membership is comprised of over 200 people associated with academic, federal, state, county, court, firm, and other private law libraries in the Western United States, Canada, and the Pacific.

PURPOSE

WestPac is a nonprofit association that promotes law librarianship through activities that enrich the professional lives of individuals. The association provides professional programs for members and fosters a spirit of cooperation and resource sharing. WestPac also strives to assist its members in working with patrons to improve access to legal information.

BENEFITS

WestPac members receive a subscription to WestPac News published three times a year.

WestPac makes grant money available for its members to attend its annual fall meeting.

WestPac members are also a resource to contact for information on library services and opportunities in their areas.
